Ephesians 5:15 See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise,

MEANING: Circumspectly - Diligently, carefully, accurately

Ephesians 5:8-14 For ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light: (For the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness and righteousness and truth;) Proving what is acceptable unto the Lord. And have no fellowship (**cont..**)

1. God wants us to be Saved.
