Thank you all once again for staying with us through the ups and downs in the ministry here in Mongolia! We have greatly enjoyed hearing from you and working with you over the years!

The ministry here has seen exciting growth with two more young people training to teach the children's Sunday School class. A church family has developed a burden to reach their family in a distant city with the Gospel, so we are all planning how to reach out to them this month! The monthly mid-week service at a church family's home was great this month with 14 in attendance and a great night of prayer, fellowship, and Bible study! Church has been full recently with 30+ people in attendance with regular visitors hearing the Gospel! We also had a great time with our church family and a few visitors out horse riding by the river near the campground! We have hosted several more Gospel gym nights, and sold several more Bibles. We also have the opportunity to help a young couple from our church as they have begun pastoring another church several hours from the city!

Nicole's adoption process has taken some twists and turns this month! Big thanks to Miss Deborah and Prairie Baptist Church for helping us with the funds needed to get our case seen concerning whether we are qualified to adopt in Mongolia! The meeting was postponed until Wednesday October 8th. During this delay, we and our lawyer have put together the many necessary documents for the last step of this process which is pairing Nicole to our family. This paperwork will now be included in this meeting. Everyone involved says our case is a shoe-in for approval; please pray with us concerning the outcome of Wednesday's meeting!

Please pray with us for wisdom as we are beginning to see the need for two upcoming trips to the states. The first is for Nicole's citizenship. When her adoption is completed here, she needs to enter the US quickly in order to gain her American citizenship easily. Our tentative plan is for Ashley, Maverick, and Nicole to visit for a few weeks sometime before Christmas to get all the necessary paperwork processed.

The second trip is for a short fund-raising quest. We have not taken a furlough since we arrived in Mongolia seven years ago, and have a few reasons for this trip: Firstly, our boys are growing, and with the addition of our daughter, our family would greatly benefit from a slight increase in our monthly finances. Secondly, as our ministry and family are growing, we have a few specific ministry and personal projects for which we would like to raise some funds. Thirdly, we have been reaching out to our supporters more often recently for financial help with specific projects that pop up; thank you all so much for being so understanding and supportive of this. However, we would rather raise a bit more regular support on this trip and be able to handle these projects within our regular monthly donations without consistently asking you all for extra funds. Our tentative plan is for Tiberius and me to visit for a couple weeks next summer, present the ministry here as many times as possible, and pray that the Lord provides the before-mentioned extra funds.
